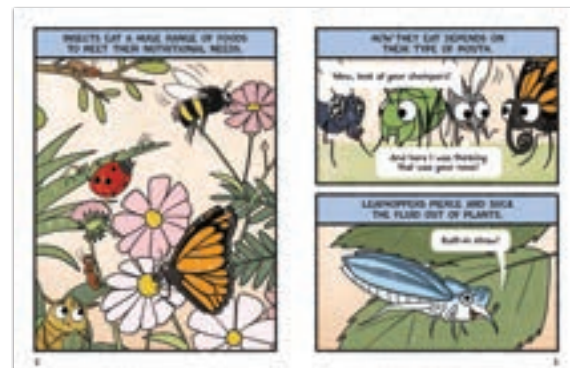
Burt the Beetle Chows Down!

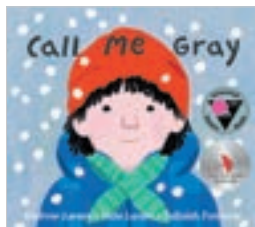


I Built a Rocket Ship
